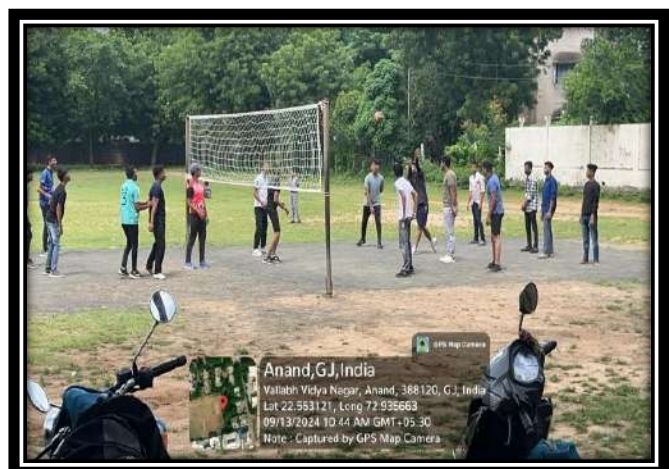
Anand Commerce College, Anand, held volleyball tournament selection at APC Ground, V.V. Nagar, on 13th September 2024 at 10:30 AM.
