#### Auditorium



Anand Commerce College (ACC) was established under the Shri Ram Krishna Seva Mandal Trust on June 15, 1970. The founder of Shri Ramkrishna Seva Mandal, the late Dr. G. S. Patel, popularly known as "Vakil Saheb," was a man of foresight who realized the need for a commerce college for the people of the Charotar area.

B.Com. degree programme in specialization of accounts and auditing (both in English and Gujarati medium), BBA degree programme in specialization of marketing, finance, and HRM (English medium), BCA degree programme in specialization of computer applications (self-financed, English medium), and B.Voc. degree programme in specialization of banking and financial services are offered by this college. From June 2024 Anand Institute of Business Studies has been merged with Anand Commerce College with BBA (ISM), BBA (Gen.), M.Com & B. Com on Self Financed basis. All faculties of the college are well qualified as per UGC norms.

The college also has NSS, NCC, and a personality development programme for the overall development of the students. Previously his works were appreciated and quoted but the Nobel Prize gave his works official recognition worldwide. Principal Dr. V. M. Vanar is an outstanding scholar and dynamic administrator. He is a Ph d guide. Two candidates have been awarded Ph d under his supervision, 07 Students are pursuing their doctoral studies under him.

02 Students have been awarded doctoral degrees under the supervision of Dr. K. V. Solanki senior faculty of the college.

Principal Dr. V. M. Vanar is a member of NAAC Peers team and he visited two institutes for NAAC Accreditation.

Throughout the year the faculty members have attended seminars, conferences, workshops at various State, National Level and participated in Faculty Development programmes organized by KCG.

Innovation is of prime importance to make the process of teaching-learning and evaluation relevant with changing times in Communication Technology. Artificial Intelligence is making inroads in the field of education. I am happy to tell you that the college organized A One Day National Seminar on Empowering Educators in Commerce in the age of Artificial Intelligence. The seminar was sponsored by the Indian Council of Social Science Research/ ICSSR. The council has released a grant of Rs. 1 lac for the seminar. 214 delegates participated in the seminar. 62 Research Papers were published in Research Metrics Journal.

This year college has signed several MoUs with various organizations for training, internship, expert lectures, industrial visits and holistic development. These organizations include Anand Nikunj and Company LLP, Prajapita Brahma Kumari Ishwariya Vishwavidyalay, Sai Cones, Sardar Patel Commerce College, Success Overseas Consultant, Tripcon Engineering Private Limited, UKA Tarsada University and Yasheel food pvt ltd.

Finishing School:

As a part of Skill enhancement and employability the college successfully conducted Finishing School programme of 80 hours. 28 students benefitted from this. The KCG provided master trainers and financial assistance for the same.

Placement:

Career Counselling and Placement Unit of the college has been active. Special classes for various State Level and National Level competitive exams were conducted. The duration of this programme was 200 hours. Placement cell also organized ICICI bank Relationship Manager Interview, Study Abroad Seminar, Collabera Associate talent specialist selection process, Acron Universal Consultancy LLP Selection process and TCS aptitude test.

This year 118 Books & Reference Books worth Rs. 99000 were purchased for the updation of the college library. The college promotes digital initiatives for the use of Library. College is a subscriber of INFLIBNET. 1064 Students of the college regularly use N-List facility for E-Resources which include Journals, Magazines and Scholarly Ph D thesis. In June 2024 Anand Commerce College topped the list of Active Users in N-list facility.

Every year IQAC of college collects analyze feedback from Stakeholders on regular basis. Necessary recommendations are discussed in IQAC and governing body and submitted to the University.

The College has received Three Stars from GSIRF, participated in NIRF and submitted the reports to AICTE for affiliation of BBA and BCA programmes.

College is also in the advance stage of receiving the Autonomous status.

College in collaboration with Bombay Stock Exchange and SBI Capital organized a Job Oriented programme for Mutual Fund Distributorship. Anand Commerce College is the first commerce college in Gujarat to be selected. SBI Capital Ltd donated Rs. 50000 to BSE institute ltd. The duration of the training programme was 50 hours. 19 students Cleared NISM exam and 50 students completed the training programme. This course will enhance scope for Job Opportunities and Start up.


#### **Youth Festival**


# Bhartiya Sanskriti Gyan Pariksha
