This Orientation Programme was coordinated and managed by Dr.Kajal B Rao.

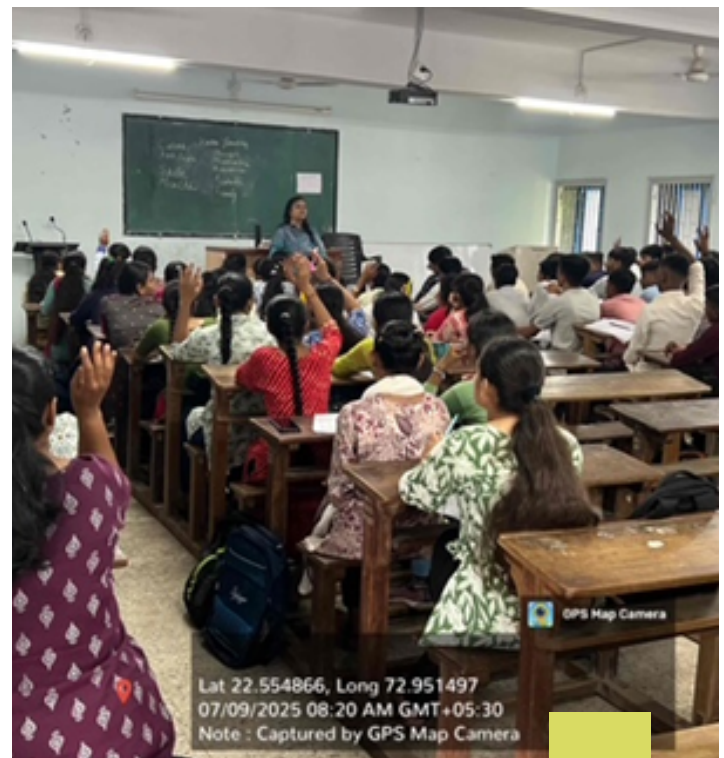

This camp was a significant step toward health consciousness and social responsibility within the college community.



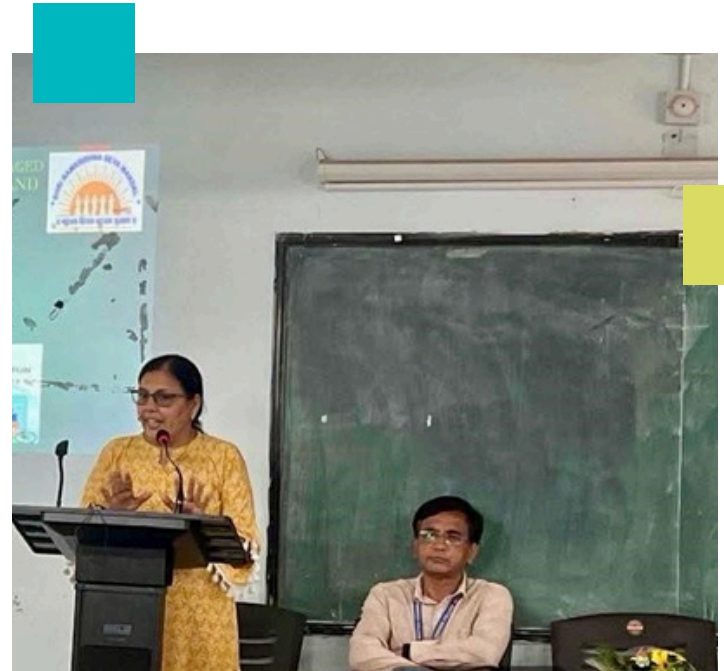
