Patel, popularly known as "Vakil Saheb," was a man of foresight who realized the need for a commerce college for the people of the Charotar area.

B.Com. degree programme in specialization of accounts and auditing (both in English and Gujarati medium), BBA degree programme in specialization of marketing, finance, and HRM (English medium), BCA degree programme in specialization of computer applications (self-financed, English medium), and B.Voc. degree programme in specialization of banking and financial services are offered by this college. From June 2024 Anand Institute of Business Studies has been merged with Anand Commerce College with BBA (ISM), BBA (Gen.), M.Com & B. Com on Self Financed basis. All faculties of the college are well qualified as per UGC norms.

The college also has NSS, NCC, and a personality development programme for the overall development of the students. 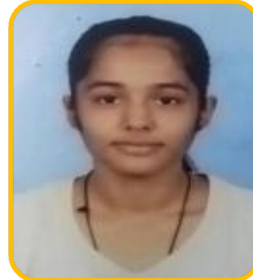

Track 1: Indigenous Values, National Unity and Social Harmony

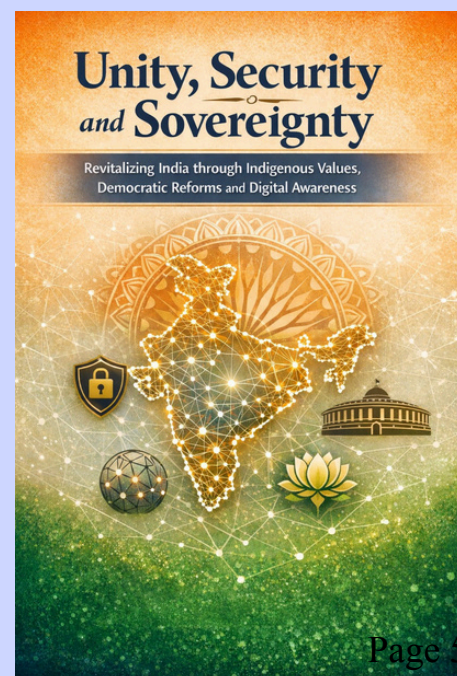
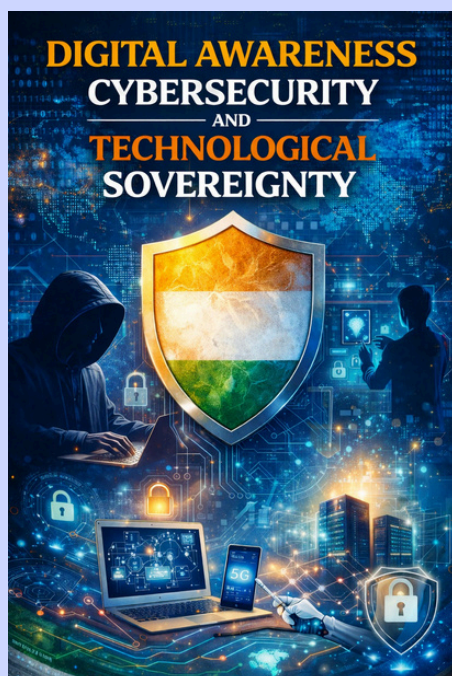
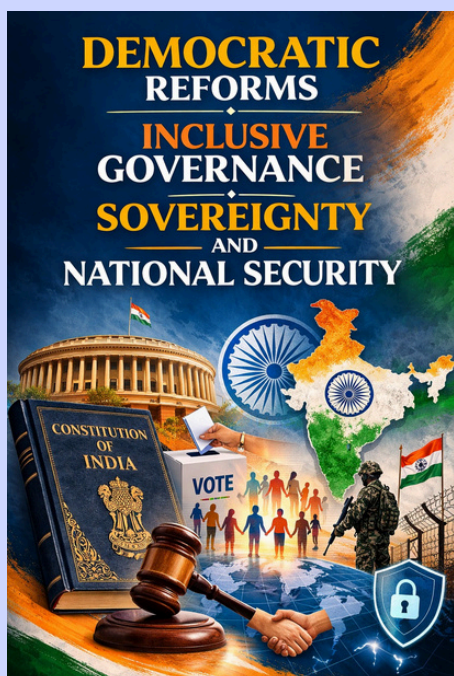
Track 2: Democratic Reforms, Inclusive, Governance, Sovereignty and National Security

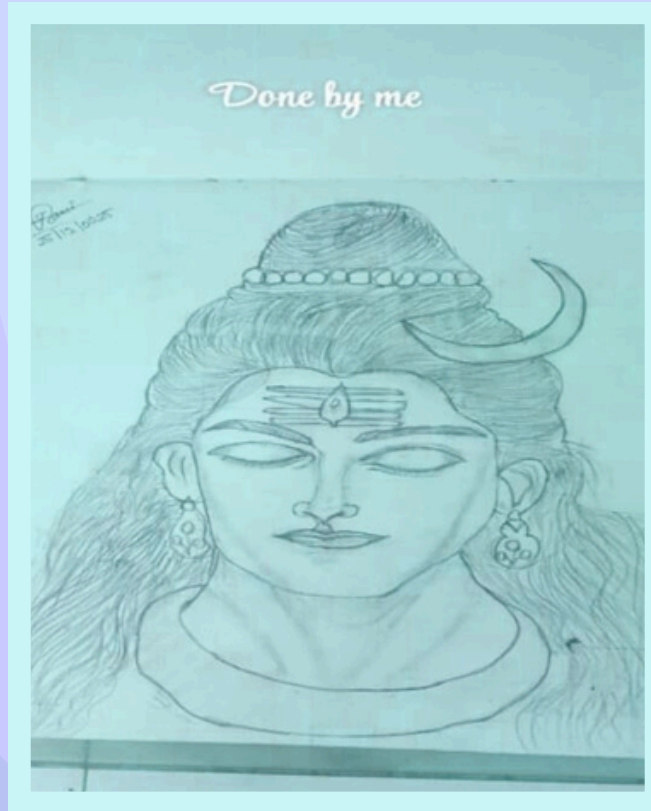

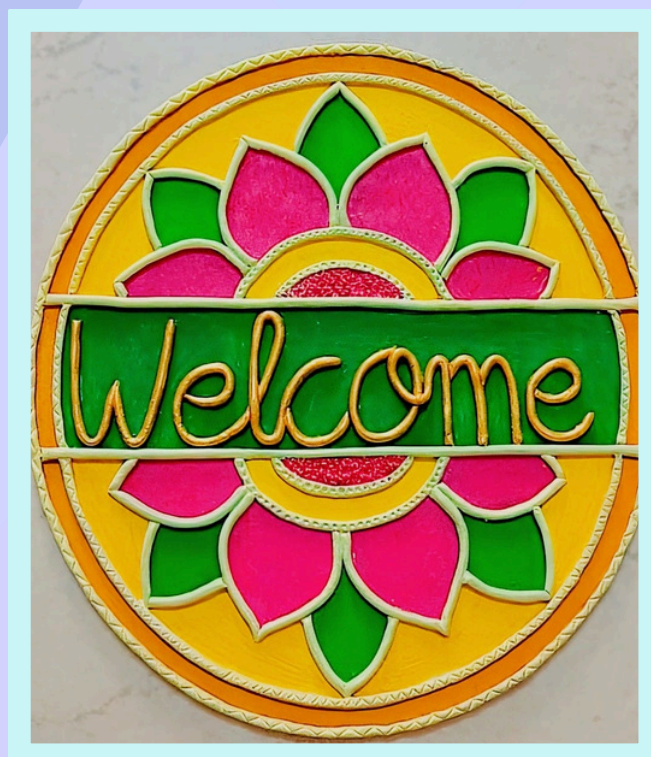
