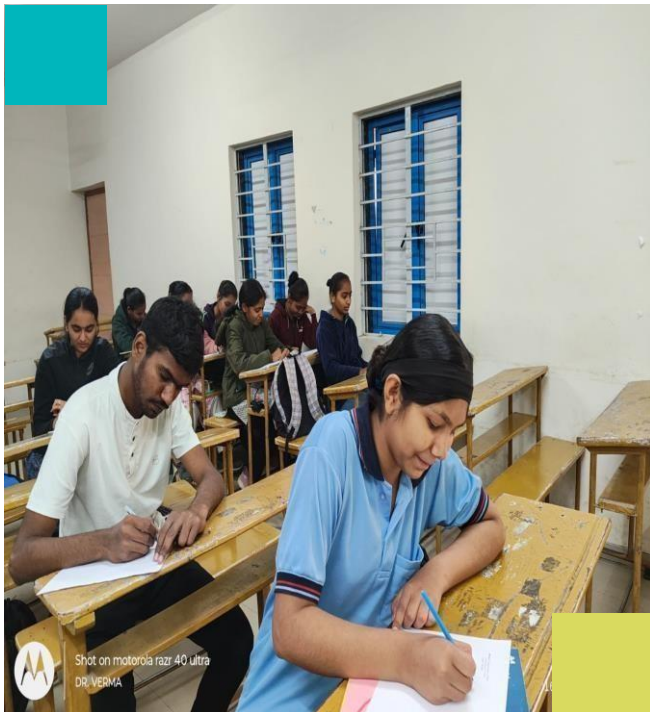
Expert session on “Creative Thinking and Innovation”
